Prior to the 27th of February 2012: The makeup of squad entries may be edited, should the need arise, without consequence.

From 27th February 2012 until registration on the Saturday: Reserves may be substituted for squad members without penalty. The reserve will have the option of competing in all events where the replaced individual was entered, in the same start position, and scoring for the championships will be unaffected. At discretion of the management committee, squads may be given the option to amend their squad entry and times.

From registration Saturday until registration Sunday: The reserve has the option of competing in all remaining Saturday events where the replaced individual was entered, in the same start position. The reserve may win medals in races; however they will not count towards the squad results in any way. The scoring for the Nationals on Sunday will be unchanged by the inclusion of a reserve (although team must obviously conform to usual entry requirements), but any team including a reserve cannot count toward the squad results.

Should you be substituting someone also entered at the Championships as an individual: The individual is free to swim in both the events in which they were entered and those of the person replaced. If this causes them to be duplicated in an event they will swim with their original entry time. Reserves of differing sex: A reserve of differing sex may only be used to form a team for the Nationals on Sunday. They may not swim in the original races.
