Emily: We at least should publicise that we're aware of it so clubs know what's up.

Ben: We have 4 months until the first competition, so we have time to think/discuss/look at developments.

Ellie M: Can we publicise a deadline by which we will make an announcement/decision?

Michael: Would need to have an EGM to re-organise league calendar

Can we speak to clubs who are hosting in term 1 to see when they need to know by?

Emma: To ensure that finances aren't ruined Ben: I will speak to the three clubs who are organising before January to find out their situation. I will also be writing a report and include a section about Covid and the league.

Ellie L: Would Bristol still get freshers after Christmas?

Ben: Would have to see how it goes in EGM

Ellie: Is a big part of recruitment and uncertainty on comps

Emily: But so will everything else.

Ellie L: Is there a potential problem with insurance if something pandemic-related related?

Michael: If all clubs are with RLSS, should be insured Emily: Most insurance doesn't cover covid-19
